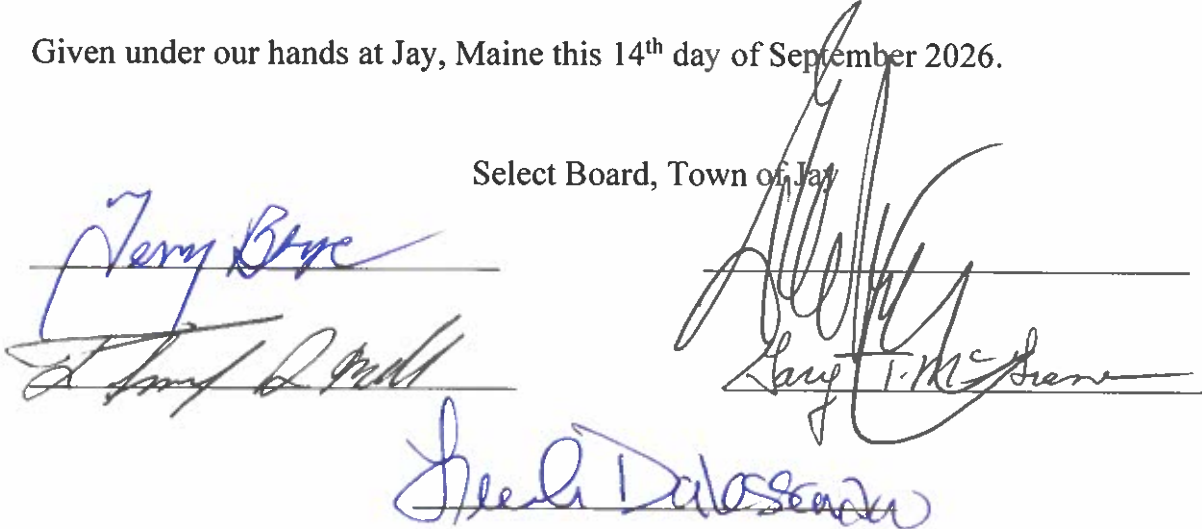
Adoption of General Assistance Ordinance dated September 2026 And Adoption of General Assistance Appendices A-H
